NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

MEDIA BULLETIN

DATED: 05/04/2020 Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **208 countries** / **territories** including India till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka state has strengthened all surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

"As of 5:00 PM of 5th April 2020, 151 COVID-19 positive cases have been confirmed in the state which includes 4 deaths & 12 discharges"

Out of 135, 132 COVID-19 positive patients (including 1 pregnant woman) are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and 3 *in ICU* (P43 on oxygen and P101 & P102 on Ventilators).

7 new cases have been confirmed in the state of Karnataka from 04.04.2020, 5:00 PM to 05.04.2020 5:00 PM.

Today's Updates

Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) has issued advisory to start rapid Antibody based blood test for COVID-19 as a strategy for areas reporting clusters (Containment Zone) and in large migration, gathering / evacuees centres.

In 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 243 people have been screened on 04.04.2020 and till on date 1839 people have been screened. Home Quarantine Enforcement squad have quarantined 10 persons in institutions on 04.04.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 371 have been shifted from home Ouarantine to institutional quarantine. The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this department has arranged for mental health counseling of such patients and contacts 1,398 sessions were held on 04.04.2020 and so far 23,562 number of counseling sessions have been held. 5 Any person who has attended Tablighi Jamaat Congregation at Nizamuddin Markaz Masjid in New Delhi, kindly contact 080-29711171 Arogya Sayavaani. 210 lines have been reserved for receiving calls of COVID-19 on 04.04.2020 calls 11,830 have been received and around 16,947 calls have outgone along with 11 manual calls has been done, for whom necessary guidance has been provided.

Appeal to Public: Any person who has returned from COVID-19 affected countries or has been in personal contact with such person must remain in home isolation for 14 days from arrival in India irrespective of having any symptoms or not. Also, should self-notify to nearest government hospital or call 104 health helpline. Maintain personal hygiene, use tissue paper/handkerchief while coughing or sneezing, frequently wash hands with soap and water or hand sanitizer and avoid attending mass social gatherings.
