NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

MEDIA BULLETIN

DATED: 12/04/2020 Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **213 Countries** / **Territories** including India till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

"As of 5:00 PM of 12th April 2020, Cumulatively 232 COVID-19 positive cases have been confirmed in the State, it includes 6 Deaths & 54 Discharges"

Out of remaining 172 cases, 168 COVID-19 positive patients (including 1 pregnant woman) are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and 4 *in ICU* (P43, P101, P108-K & P195).

17 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state from 11.04.2020, 5:00 PM to 12.04.2020 5:00 PM.

Programmatic Updates

2	In order to control the case fatalities, the elderly, those with co-morbidities, immuno-compromised patients with COVID-19 requires advanced health care at appropriate time. Hence, a Critical Care Support (CCS) Team is constituted at the State level to provide medical advise to the treating physicians of all Government Hospitals in Karnataka. Dr. K.V. Thrilok Chandra IAS, has been appointed as Special Officer for High Risk COVID-19 cases and will be heading the CCS Team. In 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 191 people have been screened on 11.04.2020 and till on date 3131 people have been screened.
3	Home Quarantine Enforcement Squad have quarantined 7 persons in Institutions on 11.04.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 462 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.
4	The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this department has arranged for Mental Health Counseling of such patients and contacts 1,421 sessions were held on 11.04.2020 and so far 32,946 number of counseling sessions have been held counseling sessions for migrants.

210 lines have been reserved for receiving calls of COVID-19 on 11.04.2020 calls **4,490** have been received and around **9,191** calls have outgone along with 8 manual calls has been done, for whom necessary guidance has been provided.

Appeal to Public: Any person who has returned from COVID-19 affected Countries or has been in personal contact with such person must remain in Home Isolation for 14 days from arrival in India irrespective of having any symptoms or not. Also, should self-notify to nearest Government Hospital or free call 104 – Arogya Sahayavani, Health Helpline. Maintain personal hygiene, use tissue paper/handkerchief while coughing or sneezing, frequently wash hands with soap
