Darghas throughout the state and to suspend the visit of public on the occasion of SHAB-E-BARAT on thursday, 9th April 2020.

No public shall be allowed to perform religious rituals in the Qabrasthans / Darghas and all the gates of Qabrasthans / Darghas shall be kept closed.

All managements of Qabrasthans / Darghas shall take necessary action on the above directions and all Waqf officers, District Waqf Advisory Committee in state shall adhere to the orders and directed to circulate the same and to ensure the order is followed scrupulously.
